S -- Self is in Control


S – Self is in Control

C – Christ is in this life and in control


C – Christ is outside this life

3. HOW TO BE DIRECTED AND EMPOWERED BY THE HOLY SPIRIT?

- a) **Confess** any known sin. (Psalm 66:18)
- b) **Surrender** every area of your life to Christ. (Romans 6:12, 13)
- c) **Ask** the Holy Spirit to direct and empower you.

We know it is God’s will because He commanded us to be filled (directed and empowered).

“Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery. Instead, be filled with the Spirit.” Ephesians 5:18

- d) **Claim** His promise by faith.
He said He would answer any prayer that is in line with His will.

TELLING MY STORY

You have received Jesus Christ as your personal Saviour. God has worked uniquely in your life. Telling your story to your friends is a wonderful way for you to illustrate what it means receive Jesus Christ. You will want to make it clear and attractive, yet simple so that those who hear it will want to know Him too, and will also know **how** to receive Him personally.

A Few Suggestions to Help You:

1. Ask the Lord to give you wisdom and guidance as you write.
(Read James 1:5, 6)
2. When you tell your story speak clearly and in a natural, relaxed tone.
3. Write and tell your story in such a way that others will identify with you in your past and present experiences.
4. Don't give the impression that the Christian life is problems free. Share that the life of Jesus Christ - who now lives in you - has given you the strength and wisdom to go through difficult times in your life.
5. Edit carefully and rewrite as necessary before your final draft.
6. Memorise your story and practice it until you can share it naturally.
7. Study the four-point outline below and write your story on the **TELLING MY STORY** worksheet.

My Life Before I Received Christ:

- Remember, you will be talking to people who do not know Christ. Could they relate to your experiences? Is your story realistic?
- Describe what your life was like before you received Jesus Christ.
- What caused you to realise that you needed to receive Christ?

How I Received Christ:

- **Specifically, how did you actually invite Jesus Christ into your life?**
- Someone should want to, and know how to receive Jesus Christ as a result of hearing your story? Make sure this is very clear!

My Life After I Received Christ:

- Use simple, clear illustrations of the positive changes He has made in your life such as changes in your attitudes, from: apathy to love; resentment to concern; depression to joy; anxiety to peace; impatience to patience.
- What does Christ mean to you now?
- Your illustrations should be realistic? Remember, no one is perfect.
- Show that it is Christ who is making the difference in your life?

Appropriate Bible Verse:

- Choose a verse that expresses your appreciation for God and what He has done in giving you His life and a new hope for the future.

When Telling Your Story, Be Sure to:

- Share from your heart and with loving enthusiasm in the power of the Holy Spirit. (Ephesians 5:18)
- **Smile!** Ask the Lord to give you a happy, radiant face!
