Lesson Two

KNOWING GOD'S CHARACTER

An amazing truth is given to us in Daniel 11:32b: "But the people who know their God will display strength and take action!" We all want to live lives that are productive and strong in character. Therefore, we must "know our God". Not to know God is to stumble through life blindfolded, with no sense of direction and no understanding of what is happening around us.

In this lesson, we will look at the character of God and discover what sets Him apart as uniquely different from us. An understanding of God will bring purpose and meaning to our daily lives.

HOW WELL DO YOU KNOW GOD?

Are you struggling with the issues of life or are you living in the confidence that God is in control? You will never be the same if you begin to live in the light of what you learn about your God. Those who have lived through difficult circumstances are more than conquerors, simply because they knew their God, understood His sovereignty and responded accordingly.

Each member of the Godhead - Father, Son and Holy Spirit have the same essential being or character.

God's character can be seen in two ways:

1. ATTRIBUTES BELONGING EXCLUSIVELY TO GOD

SOVEREIGN ETERNAL UNCHANGING

ALL POWERFUL ALL KNOWING EVERYWHERE PRESENT

2. ATTRIBUTES THAT REVEAL GOD AS HE RELATES TO HIS CREATION

HOLY RIGHTEOUS JUST LOVE

1. ATTRIBUTES THAT BELONG EXCLUSIVELY TO GOD

SOVEREIGN - God is supreme ruler above all of His creation.

RIGHTEOUS - God always does the right thing. Since He is God, whatever He does is ultimately good because He is absolute truth. His actions are always motivated by His love.			
The Bible says: Deuteronomy 32:3, 4			
Romans 8:28			

What it means: God's motives are always right. When He gives us direction for our lives, we can always be sure that it is true and right, even when it seems contrary to our human desires and wisdom.

God is teaching me		
JUST - God is impartial and right in all His actions. In perfect equity (legal fairness), He rewards righteousness and punishes sin.		
The Bible says: Nehemiah 9:13, 33		
II Thessalonians 1:3-10		
What it means: God, who is the judge of all, will see that justice is fully met. This is encouraging for those who are mistreated in this life. It is also a warning to those who do evil. God hates evil and it will be punished. God tells us to live clean, righteous lives and made it possible for us to receive His righteousness through Jesus Christ's death. (II Corinthians 5:21)		
God is teaching me		
LOVE - God is perfect and infinite love. He gives His love freely and without considering the worthiness of the one being loved. The greatest act of love ever displayed by God toward us is sending Jesus to die for our sins. (Romans 5:8)		
The Bible says: John 3:16		
Romans 8:37-39		

What it means : God loves us unconditionally. His love never changes. He loves us perfectly. He has placed His love in us (Romans 5:5). Jesus Christ living in us makes it possible for us to love others as He loves us. (1 John 4:7)
